The organization known as CATOE (Chicago Area Theatre Organ Enthusiasts) is presenting a concert of Vaudeville music at the University of St Mary of the Lake Seminary in Mundelein, Illinois

CATOE is a group of men and women who take great pride in restoring the great theatre organs that are still present in the Chicago land area. One of the organs that they have very carefully restored is located at the auditorium of St Mary of the Lake in Mundelein. This Wurlitzer organ was originally built for the Chicago Theatre in 1921. It was later acquired by Cardinal Mundelein and moved to its present location. This is not a church organ; this is a pipe organ featuring over 1500 pipes and a console that rises up out of the orchestra pit to stage level. You will be thrilled at the sounds and music that can be played on this beautiful organ.

The concert will feature four of the CATOE members playing vaudeville music on the Wurlitzer organ and Mr. Mark Teresi of the University of St Mary, signing favorite Vaudeville songs. In an addition we will have a sing along of vaudeville songs and a silent movie with the music provided by the theatre organ.

The concert starts at 2: 30 PM with a outdoor reception and the concert will start at 3PM. Admission is \$20.00 and tickets can be purchased from CATOE at 630 892 8136, or at 1 847 566 1347. Tickets will be available at the concert.
